Occupational Health - Needle Stick Injury Procedure

- Should an individual sustain a needle stick injury, the first port of call would be to visit their local hospital with an A&E department.
- The A&E department will take blood samples and send them off for testing.
- Once the blood test results have been received, please email them to David Barber Occupational Health Ltd for review. The email address is <u>Kate@dbocchealth.com</u>
- Our Occupational Health Advisor (OHA) will review the results. The OHA will advise if they need to speak to the individual in more detail to discuss their results.
- If a telephone consultation is required between the individual and the OHA, the cost is £75.00. which is payable by the company/surgery that the individual works for. Our invoices are sent out after work has been completed and have a 10-day payment terms. A fit note will also be issued with any advice or recommendations once the telephone consultation has been completed.
